INTRODUCTION

We would like to say thank you to all those who have previously joined in our Horse Fun Rides, and welcome to all those thinking of taking part. This leaflet provides all the dates of our rides for the 2010 season, together with details of the rides, times and prices for those who haven't been before.

The Cotswold Farm Park is part of the 650 ha Bemborough Farm, which is a mixed farm, high on the Cotswold Hills, 900 ft above sea level.

Throughout the year we run a series of horse fun rides, open to all horse owners. These take place through some of the Cotswold's most beautiful scenery, including woodland trails, grass gallops, open hills and across the river Windrush.

The ride starts and finishes at the Cotswold Farm Park itself, where hot and cold refreshments are available in our Cotswold Kitchen, there is plenty of free parking, and, of course, toilets.

LOCATION DIRECTIONS

From Stow on the Wold

Take the B4077 Tewkesbury road for 5 miles. At the crossroads with the Broadway to Bourton on the Water road, turn left, following the Farm Park sign. The Farm Park is then on your right in 1 1/4 miles.

From Tewkesbury and M5 Junction 9

Take the B4077 Stow on the Wold road through Ford, then turn right at the Farm Park sign on the crossroads, towards Bourton on the Water. The Farm Park is on your right in 1 1/4 miles.

From Cheltenham

Take the A40 Oxford road, turning left onto the A436 for Stow on the Wold at Andoversford. After approximately 5 miles turn left onto the B4068 and 4 miles later left again at the crossroads with the Bourton on the Water - Broadway road. Follow signs to the Cotswold Farm Park on the left hand side.



CONDITIONS OF ENTRY



All riders must register at the start of a Fun Ride, providing full name, address and emergency contact details. Numbers are issued to all riders to wear whilst on the course. Riders must sign back in at the end of their ride. A check is made at the end of the event to ensure all riders have returned safely.

All riders are requested to take a mobile telephone with them, and are provided with a ticket giving emergency contact telephone numbers of Farm Park staff to contact, in case of an accident around the course. All jumps are individually numbered to identify them in case of an accident.

All jumps are marked with red and white arrows and riders must not jump other walls, fences and obstacles. Riders must keep the jumps clear for following riders and to allow their safe passage.

A responsible person over the age of 18 must supervise riders under the age of 14.

Riders under the age of 8 years old, and riders who have not demonstrated riding proficiency to the satisfaction of the organisers, are only allowed on the course with lead reins.

All riders will wear helmets complying with BS6473 and all footwear worn by riders will have well defined heels.

Dogs are not allowed to accompany riders or spectators on the route and no vehicles are allowed on the route.
