

**Plump Hill Kentucky Fund Raising Ride**  
**All Proceeds to the British WEG Endurance team**  
**26<sup>th</sup> September 2010**

**Start time/Venue**

**Any time between 0930 and 1130.**

We are fortunate in having **A NEW VENUE** at Shapridge Farm, Church Lane, nr Flaxley. This provides direct access into the forest and has meant we can extend the route to include some tracks not previously accessible. The venue is a field with no facilities, although we plan to provide tea, coffee and cakes for a small charge. Water and toilet are available in emergency at the farm yard. Directions- from the A4136 Huntley direction (towards Monmouth), proceed to Mitcheldean. Just before the mini-roundabout on the Huntley side turn left towards Flaxley/Littledean. Continue until reaching a sharp right hand bend, where you will find Church Lane on your left. Take this road, bearing left and right, continuing after it becomes a farm track. The entrance to the venue will be on your left, through the farm yard. From the A4136 Monmouth direction, come downhill to Mitcheldean, until reaching the mini-roundabout. Turn right just after and follow the above directions. It is intended to sign the venue from the A4136.

**The Route**

Ride route maps are to be collected on the day due to late route changes just received back from the Forestry. Subject to the weather remaining dry, we have been permitted to use some new tracks which provide good undulating going. The route will be marked by spray-painted arrows or shavings at junction points. The short route is approx 16k and the long route approx 24k. The route crosses the A4136 twice. Please take care crossing this road, particularly as visibility is limited. It is your responsibility to ensure that the road is clear before crossing. The Forest is used by ramblers, dog walkers and mountain bikers. Please show consideration for everyone you meet, and walk past. You will encounter low branches, undergrowth and tree routes as you would expect in Forestry. Please be aware of these and exercise due caution. Please note that as the venue is down a single track lane, crewing on course is discouraged. There is a water point on the longer route where drinking water and sloshes will be available.
